Pregnant mom delivers baby after being shot while leaving Dallas church:

A Texas woman who was eight months pregnant was caught in the crossfire of a broad-daylight shooting outside her church over the weekend, police said.

The woman was leaving a church service in Dallas around 1 p.m. Sunday when at least



two men began shooting at each other in the parking lot, according to police. The victim was struck by one of the bullets and had to be rushed to the hospital, the Dallas Police Department said in a statement.

Doctors were able to deliver the premature baby and both the mom

and her child were in stable condition, authorities said. The extent of their injuries was not immediately disclosed.

Surveillance images obtained by investigators show three men in the parking lot, with [two of them pointing their weapons](#) at each other.

The shooters left the scene before cops arrived and have yet to be identified. Police said the men, who were believed to be Black, were driving a champagne Nissan sedan and a black Ford Focus.

Warren's Notes:

A few lesson's learned here. One, it is so vitally that if anything is going on outside that can harm anyone, we have got to be ready to lock the building down. No one in or out until it is all clear. Secondly, If we are outside and we hear shots, we need to get everyone down on the ground as fast as possible. If someone had taken the time to get her down, she might not have been shot. Third, who was getting the description of the men? Granted, safety has to be first, but could someone have noticed anything the cameras did not pick up like Tatoos, types or guns, any words that might have been uttered, etc.
